A psychologist called Sherif suggested in 1936 that of a <i>group</i> of people often influences the behaviour of a <i>single</i> person. In other words, people opy. 	Asch's most famous work is called the Line Experiment. He conducted this experiment in 1952. The experiment involved pictures of lines of different lengths. Asch told participants that they were taking part in a vision test. In fact, they were being tested on conformity. Asch wanted to see whether a person would conform to a majority view, even when it was obviously wrong.
