

#### STUDY SKILLS: Look for the main information

### Venice

Venice is a city in the north of Italy. It is the capital of the area called Veneto. It is built on more than 100 islands separated by 150 canals, at the top of the Adriatic Sea.

Around 400 bridges connect the islands that form Venice. A single road and rail link connect it to the mainland. This link is protected from the sea by sandbanks. One large canal, the Grand Canal, goes from north to south and divides the city into two.

There are no cars on the islands of Venice. The bridges are for pedestrians only. For hundreds of years, the most common method of transport was the gondola, a traditional boat controlled by a single oar. Today, these boats are mostly for tourists; small motorboats transport local people.



St Mark's

Tourism is very important to the economy. Every year, millions of tourists visit the city to walk around St Mark's Square, explore the canals and enjoy the annual film festival. The large islands of Murano and Burano are famous for glass products and Venetian lace.
